

Boarding Policies, and Required Vaccinations for Boarding, Daycare and Training

Our Boarding Policies

To ensure that your pet's stay is comfortable and enjoyable, we ask that you observe the following policies:

- Mark all of your pet's accompanying belongings with a permanent marker.
- Please limit toys to a maximum of two that are softball size or larger. Note: With all of the activity surrounding them, most pets do not play with the toys you send with them.
- You may bring your own food for your pet but bring only enough for your pet's stay with us, as we do not have storage space for large bags of food.
- Our service includes keeping fresh, clean bedding and dishware in your pet's boarding space, so we ask that you not bring bedding for your pet.

Our staff loves animals, so you can rest assured your pet's needs will be met with care and concern.

These are the vaccinations required for boarding, training and daycare to keep all of our pets safe and healthy.

Required Vaccinations for Pet Boarding

Dogs

- Rabies
- Distemper
- Bordetella Vaccine for Canine Cough (annually)
- Canine Flu Vaccine
- Negative Heartworm Test (annually)
- Intestinal Parasite Screen (every six months)

Cats

- Rabies
- Distemper
- Feline Leukemia Test or Vaccine
- Intestinal Parasite Screen (every six months)

Note about Fecals (Intestinal Parasite Screen): Required within prior six months of boarding date at Union Lake Pet Services. If one has not been done prior to boarding, we will do one during pet's stay and immediately treat any parasites we find.

Vaccinations Required for Doggy Daycare

- Rabies after 4 months of age
- Distemper Combo Vaccine series needs to have been started for puppies

- Flu Vaccine
- Negative Heartworm Test (annually)
- Bordetella Vaccine for Cough (annually)
- Negative Intestinal Parasite Screening (every six months)

Vaccinations Required for Dog Training

Puppies must be started on their Distemper series, current on Bordetella vaccine, Rabies vaccine (at 4 months), Heartworm test (at 1 year old) and Fecal test (every 6 months).

Dogs must be started on their Distemper series, current on annual Bordetella vaccine, Rabies vaccine, Flu vaccine, Heartworm test and Fecal (every 6 months).
